

**General Charles H. Noble.**

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind., March 4.—Brig. Gen. Charles H. Noble, U. S. A., retired, a veteran of the civil war and Spanish-American wars, in which he commanded a regiment at the battle of San Juan Hill, died suddenly at his home here today, in his seventy-fourth year.

He was born in Dayton, Ohio, and enlisted at the outbreak of the civil war, being mustered out as a Captain of volunteers. General Noble was commissioned a Second Lieutenant in the regular army, and in the Spanish-American war was sent to Cuba in command of a battalion of the Sixteenth Infantry.
